18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That Section(s) 7–402 through 7–417, respectively, of Article – General Provisions of the
20 Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–403 through 7–418,
21 respectively.

2 **THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE FOURTH THURSDAY IN**
3 **MARCH AS TUSKEGEE AIRMEN COMMEMORATION DAY IN RECOGNITION OF THE**
4 **TUSKEGEE AIRMEN'S CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE UNITED STATES IN WORLD WAR II**
5 **AND THEIR TIES TO MARYLAND.**

6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2018.
