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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Police Department – Community Policing Funds**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Executive Director of the Governor’s Office of Crime  
4 Control and Prevention to require a certain portion of a grant made to the Baltimore  
5 City Police Department be used towards community policing under certain  
6 circumstances; and generally relating to funds for the Baltimore City Police  
7 Department.

9 Article – Public Safety

10 Section 4–801 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 8. Baltimore City Community  
11 Policing”

12 Annotated Code of Maryland

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Public Safety**

17 **SUBTITLE 8. BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY POLICING.**

18 **4–801.**

19 **IF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR’S OFFICE OF CRIME**  
20 **CONTROL AND PREVENTION MAKES A GRANT OF \$5,000,000 OR MORE TO THE**  
21 **BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL**  
22 **REQUIRE THAT AT LEAST \$1,000,000 OF THE GRANT BE USED FOR COMMUNITY**  
23 **POLICING EFFORTS BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

1           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
2   October 1, 2018.
