circumstances.

"Outstanding warrant" means an arrest warrant that: $\mathbf{5}$ (3)6 A law enforcement agency has attempted, but failed, to (i) serve on the individual named in the warrant due to the inability to locate the 78 individual: and 9 (ii) Is at least [31] **91** days old. 10 (b) Subject to subsection (h) of this section, on notification by a law enforcement agency that an applicant for vehicle registration is named in an 11 outstanding warrant, the Administration shall refuse to register or transfer the 1213registration of any vehicle owned by the applicant. 1416 - 204.In this section the following words have the meanings indicated. 15(a) (1)"Outstanding warrant" has the meaning stated in § 13-406.1(a)(3)16 (3)17of this article. 18 (b)Subject to subsection (h) of this section, on notification by a law 19enforcement agency that an individual is named in an outstanding warrant, the 20Administration shall suspend the individual's license or privilege to drive in the State. 21SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22October 1, 2010.
