A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Agriculture – Neonicotinoid Pesticides – Restricted Use**

3 FOR the purpose of designating a neonicotinoid pesticide as a restricted use pesticide;
4 authorizing the distribution, sale, and application of a neonicotinoid pesticide
5 under certain circumstances; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to
6 restricted use pesticides.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Agriculture**

20 5–201.

21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

22 (c) “Certified applicator” means a person who is certified by the Secretary
23 under this subtitle.

1 (r) "Restricted use pesticide" means a pesticide so classified by the provisions
2 in this title or by the federal government or the Secretary of Agriculture, State of
3 Maryland.

5 (a) In this section, "cyclodiene termiticide" means chlordane (1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7,
6 8, 8-octachloro-2, 3, 3a, 4, 7, 7a-hexahydro-4, 7-methanoindene), heptachlor (1, 4, 5,
7 6, 7, 8, 8-heptachloro-3a, 4, 7, 7a-tetrahydro-4, 7-methanoindene), aldrin (1, 2, 3, 4,
8 10, 10-hexachloro-1, 4, 4a, 5, 8, 8a-hexahydro-1, 4:5, 8-dimethanonaphthalene), and
9 dieldrin (3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 9-hexachloro-1a, 2, 2a, 3, 6, 6a, 7, 7a-octahydro-2, 7:3,
10 6-dimethanonaphth (2, 3-b) oxirene) and related cyclodiene chemical compounds used
11 for the control of termites.

12 (b) (1) [On and after October 1, 1987, each] **EACH** cyclodiene termiticide
13 distributed, sold, or offered for sale in [this] **THE** State shall be classified as a
14 restricted use pesticide.

15 (2) A person may distribute, sell, or offer for sale a cyclodiene
16 termiticide only if:

17 (i) The cyclodiene termiticide is designated as a restricted use
18 pesticide in a manner determined by the Department; and

19 (ii) The purchaser is a:

20 1. Certified [pesticide] applicator; or

21 2. Registered employee who has completed a course in
22 termiticide application that is approved by the Department.

23 (3) A cyclodiene termiticide applied by a licensee shall only be applied
24 by:

25 (i) A certified [pesticide] applicator; or

26 (ii) A registered employee who has completed a course in
27 termiticide application that is approved by the Department and is making the
28 application under the direct supervision of a certified [pesticide] applicator.

29 **(C) (1) EACH NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDE DISTRIBUTED, SOLD, OR**
30 **OFFERED FOR SALE IN THE STATE SHALL BE CLASSIFIED AS A RESTRICTED USE**
31 **PESTICIDE.**

32 **(2) A PERSON MAY DISTRIBUTE, SELL, OR OFFER FOR SALE A**
33 **NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDE ONLY IF:**

1 **(I) THE NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDE IS DESIGNATED AS A**
2 **RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE IN A MANNER DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT;**
3 **AND**

4 **(II) THE PURCHASER IS A CERTIFIED APPLICATOR.**

5 **(3) A NEONICOTINOID PESTICIDE SHALL BE APPLIED ONLY BY A**
6 **CERTIFIED APPLICATOR.**

7 **[(c) (D) [Before October 1, 1987, the] THE** Department shall adopt
8 regulations to carry out the provisions of this section.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2014.
