A BILL ENTITLED

Howard County Board of Education – Elected School Board

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that, beginning with a certain election, certain members of $\mathbf{5}$ the Howard County Board of Education shall reside in certain districts and be elected 6 by the voters of the entire county and that certain members may reside anywhere in 7 the county and shall be elected at large by the voters of the entire county; providing 8 that a member elected to the county board from a certain geographic area but whose 9 district boundaries are subsequently altered may remain as a member of the county 10 board for a certain period; providing that in making an appointment to fill a vacancy 11 on the county board the County Executive of Howard County shall endeavor to 12ensure that the county board reflects certain characteristics of the county population; 13 providing for the termination of the terms of certain members of the county board; 14 providing for the terms of certain members of the county board; providing for the 15application of this Act; and generally relating to the election of the members of the 16Howard County Board of Education.
