A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicles - Emergency Commercial Driver's Licenses - Establishment

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the emergency commercial driver's license issued by the Motor Vehicle Administration; authorizing the Administration to establish a 4 5 program to authorize certain former holders of a commercial driver's license to 6 obtain, under certain circumstances, an emergency commercial driver's license 7 during certain states of emergency declared by the Governor; requiring the 8 Administration to waive a certain driver skills test for program participants; 9 establishing that an individual driving under the authority of an emergency commercial driver's license may only travel intrastate; and generally relating to the 10 11 establishment of the emergency commercial driver's license.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Transportation
- 20 **16–807.3**.
- 21 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO AUTHORIZE A
 22 FORMER HOLDER OF A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE TO OBTAIN AN EMERGENCY
 23 COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE DURING A STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED BY
- 24 THE GOVERNOR THAT IS EXPECTED TO BE IN EFFECT FOR 6 MONTHS OR MORE.



- 1 (B) UNDER THE PROGRAM, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE EMERGENCY 2 COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSES ONLY:
- 3 (1) DURING A STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED BY THE GOVERNOR 4 AND FOR 6 MONTHS FOLLOWING THE TERMINATION OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY;
- 5 (2) If the Governor determines that there is a shortage of 6 commercial driver's license holders in the State; and
- 7 (3) IF THE GOVERNOR DETERMINES THAT THE SHORTAGE OF 8 COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE HOLDERS SIGNIFICANTLY INHIBITS THE 9 TRANSPORTATION OF GOODS AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES IN THE STATE 10 DURING OR IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE STATE OF EMERGENCY.
- 11 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE AN EMERGENCY COMMERCIAL 12 DRIVER'S LICENSE ONLY:
- 13 **(1)** TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- 14 (I) HAS HELD A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED BY 15 THE ADMINISTRATION WITHIN THE PAST 5 YEARS;
- 16 (II) IS OTHERWISE QUALIFIED TO OPERATE A COMMERCIAL 17 MOTOR VEHICLE;
- 18 (III) HAS THE REQUIRED MEDICAL CERTIFICATIONS FOR 19 INTERSTATE TRAVEL UNDER A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE;
- 20 (IV) HAS PASSED THE APPROPRIATE VISION SCREENING TESTS; 21 AND
- (V) HAS THE DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW, AS ENUMERATED IN § 16–103.1(10) AND (11) OF THIS TITLE, ON FILE WITH THE ADMINISTRATION; AND
- 25 (2) IN THE SAME CLASS AND WITH THE SAME ENDORSEMENTS AS WAS 26 THE CASE FOR THE INDIVIDUAL'S PREVIOUSLY HELD COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S 27 LICENSE.
- 28 (D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL WAIVE THE SKILLS TEST REQUIRED 29 UNDER § 16–807(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS.
- 30 (E) AN INDIVIDUAL DRIVING UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF AN EMERGENCY

- 1 COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE MAY ONLY TRAVEL INTRASTATE.
- 2 (F) (1) AN EMERGENCY COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE SHALL EXPIRE 3 ON THE EARLIER OF 6 MONTHS AFTER:
- 4 (I) THE TERMINATION OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY; OR
- 5 (II) ISSUANCE.
- 6 (2) WITHIN THE PERIOD BETWEEN THE BEGINNING OF THE STATE OF
 7 EMERGENCY AND 6 MONTHS AFTER THE TERMINATION OF THE STATE OF
 8 EMERGENCY, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY RENEW AN EMERGENCY COMMERCIAL
 9 DRIVER'S LICENSE IN ITS DISCRETION.
- 10 (3) IF APPROPRIATE, AN EMERGENCY COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S 11 LICENSE SHALL BE RENEWED ELECTRONICALLY.
- 12 (G) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 13 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
