3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Housing and Community Development 4 and the Department of Planning to jointly produce a report for each State legislative 5 district on the food environment in the district on or before a certain date and at a 6 certain frequency thereafter; requiring the reports to include certain information; 7 requiring the reports to follow a certain format and be of a certain level of detail; 8 authorizing the departments to collaborate with certain universities and nonprofit 9 organizations in producing the reports required under this Act; requiring the departments to submit the reports to the General Assembly; and generally relating 10 11 to food environments in State legislative districts.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Housing and Community Development

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- 21 (A) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2021, AND ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1
- 22 EVERY 2 YEARS THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 23 Planning shall jointly produce a report for each State legislative
- 24 DISTRICT ON THE FOOD ENVIRONMENT IN THE DISTRICT.

- 3 (C) EACH REPORT PRODUCED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE IN THE SAME

- 5 LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT 2018 FOOD ENVIRONMENT BRIEFS, AS PRODUCED BY THE
- 6 BALTIMORE CITY DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND THE JOHNS HOPKINS CENTER
- 7 FOR A LIVABLE FUTURE.
- 8 (D) IN PRODUCING THE REPORTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE 9 DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING MAY COLLABORATE WITH:
- 10 (1) ANY UNIVERSITY IN THE STATE; AND
- 11 (2) ANY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT SPECIALIZES IN 12 EQUITABLE FOOD ACCESS.
- 13 (E) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING SHALL SUBMIT THE REPORTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2021.
