A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County – Alcoholic Beverages Licenses – Class D Beer License**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the authorization of certain license holders in Carroll County
4 to sell beer at retail for off-premises consumption; and generally relating to alcoholic
5 beverages in Carroll County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 16–102.

20 This title applies only in Carroll County.

21 16–604.

22 (a) There is a Class D beer license.

1 (b) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the license authorizes the
2 license holder to sell beer at retail:

3 (I) at the place described in the license for [on- and off-premises]
4 ON-PREMISES consumption; AND

5 (II) AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD, FOR OFF-PREMISES
6 CONSUMPTION.

7 (2) A license may not be issued for a drugstore.

8 (c) The annual license fee is \$250.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2019.
