HOUSE BILL 1336

- 1 Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the license authorizes the (b) (1) 2 license holder to sell beer at retail: 3 **(I)** at the place described in the license for [on- and off-premises] 4 ON-PREMISES consumption; AND 5 (II) AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD, FOR OFF-PREMISES 6 CONSUMPTION. 7 A license may not be issued for a drugstore. (2)
- 8 (c) The annual license fee is \$250.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 $\,$ 1, 2019.
