1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Alternative Therapies Fund – Establishment**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Alternative Therapies
4 Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; and generally relating to the Post-Traumatic
5 Stress Disorder Alternative Therapies Fund.

6 BY adding to

7 Article – Health – General

8 Section 24–1801 and 24–1802 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 18.
9 Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Alternative Therapies Fund”

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Health – General**

15 **SUBTITLE 18. POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER ALTERNATIVE THERAPIES**
16 **FUND.**

17 **24–1801.**

18 **(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**

2 (B) "ALTERNATIVE THERAPIES" INCLUDES HYPERBARIC OXYGEN THERAPY
3 AND PSYCHEDELICS INCLUDING 3,4-METHYLENEDIOXYMETHAMPHETAMINE
4 (MDMA), PSILOCYBIN, AND KETAMINE.

5 (C) "FUND" MEANS THE POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER
6 ALTERNATIVE THERAPIES FUND.

7 (D) "VETERAN" MEANS A FORMER MEMBER OF THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES
8 WHO WAS DISCHARGED FROM ACTIVE DUTY:

9 (1) THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES;

10 (2) A RESERVE COMPONENT OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED
11 STATES; OR

12 (3) THE NATIONAL GUARD OF ANY STATE.

13 24-1802.

14 (A) THERE IS A POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER ALTERNATIVE
15 THERAPIES FUND.

16 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO SUPPORT THE DEPARTMENT IN
17 STUDYING THE EFFECTIVENESS OF AND IMPROVING ACCESS TO ALTERNATIVE
18 THERAPIES FOR POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER IN VETERANS.

19 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

20 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT
21 SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

22 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY,
23 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

24 (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

25 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
26 AND

27 (2) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR
28 THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.

1 (F) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR:

2 (1) STUDYING THE USE OF ALTERNATIVE THERAPIES FOR VETERANS
3 WITH POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER;

4 (2) IMPROVING ACCESS TO ALTERNATIVE THERAPIES FOR VETERANS
5 WITH POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER;

6 (3) ANY USES DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER
7 SUBSECTION (I) OF THIS SECTION; AND

8 (4) ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT IN
9 ADMINISTERING THE FUND.

10 (G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND
11 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

12 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO
13 THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

14 (H) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE
15 WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

16 (I) THE DEPARTMENT PERIODICALLY SHALL CONSULT WITH THE
17 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, THE JOHNS HOPKINS UNIVERSITY, THE
18 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, SHEPPARD PRATT, AND WALTER REED NATIONAL
19 MILITARY MEDICAL CENTER TO DETERMINE:

20 (1) THE EFFECTIVENESS OF AND A METHOD FOR IMPROVING ACCESS
21 TO ALTERNATIVE THERAPIES FOR TREATING POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER
22 IN VETERANS; AND

23 (2) APPROPRIATE USES OF THE FUND THAT FURTHER THE FUND'S
24 PURPOSE UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

25 (J) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, BEGINNING IN 2024, THE
26 DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH §
27 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, A
28 REPORT ON THE USE OF THE FUND DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING FISCAL
29 YEAR.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for fiscal year 2024, the
31 Governor shall include in the annual budget bill an appropriation in an amount of

1 \$1,000,000 to the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Alternative Therapies Fund established
2 under § 24-1802 of the Health – General Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Department of
4 Health shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State
5 Government Article, the General Assembly:

6 (1) on or before December 1, 2022, its initial findings and recommendations
7 under § 24-1802(i) of the Health – General Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act; and

8 (2) on or before December 1, 2024, findings and recommendations from
9 studies funded by the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Alternative Therapies Fund
10 established under § 24-1802 of the Health – General Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this
11 Act, including:

12 (i) any findings regarding the efficacy of alternative therapies as
13 treatment for post-traumatic stress disorder; and

14 (ii) recommendations on budgetary, legislative, or regulatory
15 changes to expand access to alternative therapies for veterans with post-traumatic stress
16 disorder.

17 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
18 1, 2022.
