

13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
15	Article – Education
16	8–3A–04.
17	(a) There is a Maryland School for the Deaf.
18 19	(b) The governance of the Maryland School for the Deaf is vested in the Board of Trustees of the Maryland School for the Deaf.
20 21	(c) (1) The Board of Trustees shall consist of 19 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
22	(2) Of the 19 members, at least 6 members shall be deaf.

1	(1) Are bona fide Maryland residents; and
2	(2) Meet the admission standards of the Maryland School for the Deaf.
3 4	(j) (1) The Maryland School for the Deaf may admit out—of—state students for tuition who meet the admission standards of the Maryland School for the Deaf.
5 6	(2) The Maryland School for the Deaf shall establish tuition rates on an annual basis.
7 8 9	(K) EACH TEACHER WHO IS EMPLOYED BY THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF IS IN THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICE IN THE STATE PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM.
10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
