A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County – Law Enforcement Vehicles – Automated External**
3 **Defibrillator**

4 **MC 17-14**

5 FOR the purpose of requiring, in Montgomery County, a law enforcement agency’s
6 vehicle used for patrol by a law enforcement officer who is a first responder and
7 trained in the operation and use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) to
8 be equipped with an AED; defining certain terms; and generally relating to law
9 enforcement vehicles.

13 Annotated Code of Maryland

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Public Safety**

18 **3-509.**

19 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE**
20 **MEANINGS INDICATED.**

21 **(2) “AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR” OR “AED” HAS**
22 **THE MEANING STATED IN § 13-517 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(3) “FIRST RESPONDER” MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:**

2 **(I) IS AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL**
3 **SERVICES IN THE STATE UNDER § 13-516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE; AND**

4 **(II) PROVIDES SERVICES TO AN INDIVIDUAL BEFORE THE**
5 **INDIVIDUAL IS ADMITTED TO A HOSPITAL.**

6 **(4) “LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY” MEANS AN AGENCY THAT IS**
7 **LISTED IN § 3-101(E) OF THIS TITLE.**

8 **(B) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY’S**
9 **VEHICLE USED FOR PATROL BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO IS A FIRST**
10 **RESPONDER AND TRAINED IN THE OPERATION AND USE OF AN AED SHALL BE**
11 **EQUIPPED WITH AN AED.**

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2014.
