- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 a license issued by the Secretary before the person may:



- 1 Offer or perform medical laboratory tests or examinations in this State; (1) 2 Offer or perform medical laboratory tests or examinations on specimens 3 acquired from health care providers in this State at a medical laboratory located outside this State: or 4 5 (3)Represent or service in this State a medical laboratory regardless of the laboratory's location. 6 7 17 - 215.8 [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 17–702 OF THIS TITLE, A person may not directly or indirectly advertise for or solicit business in this State for any medical laboratory, 9 regardless of location, from anyone except a physician, hospital, medical laboratory, clinic, 10 clinical installation, or other medical care facility. 11 SUBTITLE 7. DIRECT-TO-CONSUMER GENETIC TESTING. 12 **17–701.** 13 14 IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS (A) 15 INDICATED. 16 "DIRECT-TO-CONSUMER GENETIC TEST" MEANS A GENETIC TEST THAT (B) IS OFFERED DIRECTLY TO A CONSUMER, INSTEAD OF BEING ORDERED FOR A 17 CONSUMER THROUGH A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER. 18 19 "GENETIC TEST" (C) MEANS A LABORATORY TEST \mathbf{OF} HUMAN 20 CHROMOSOMES, GENES, OR GENE PRODUCTS THAT IS USED TO IDENTIFY THE 21PRESENCE OR ABSENCE OF INHERITED OR CONGENITAL ALTERATIONS IN GENETIC 22MATERIAL THAT ARE ASSOCIATED WITH DISEASE OR ILLNESS. 23 **17-702.**

OFFER, OR PERFORM DIRECT-TO-CONSUMER GENETIC TESTING ONLY IF:

28 AMENDMENTS;

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(2) THE CONSUMER WHO ORDERS THE GENETIC TEST IS AN ADULT;

A PERSON MAY ADVERTISE FOR, SOLICIT BUSINESS IN THE STATE FOR,

(3) THE PERSON ADVISES EACH CONSUMER:

1	(I) TO TALK TO THE CONSUMER'S HEALTH CARE PROVIDER OF
2	GENETIC COUNSELOR ABOUT THE RESULTS OF THE CONSUMER'S GENETIC TEST;
3	(II) THAT THE RESULTS OF A GENETIC TEST MAY BE USED TO:
4	1. Deny or limit the amount, extent, or kind of
5	LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE COVERAGE, DISABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE, OF
6	LIFE INSURANCE COVERAGE AVAILABLE TO THE CONSUMER; OR
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7	2. CHARGE A HIGHER RATE FOR LONG-TERM CARE
8	INSURANCE, DISABILITY INSURANCE, OR LIFE INSURANCE; AND
9	(III) THAT FAILURE TO DISCLOSE THE RESULT OF A GENETIC
10	TEST ON AN APPLICATION FOR A LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE POLICY, A
11	DISABILITY INSURANCE POLICY, OR A LIFE INSURANCE POLICY COULD RESULT IN
12	CANCELLATION OF THE POLICY OR DENIAL OF COVERAGE UNDER THE POLICY;
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13	(4) THE PERSON PROVIDES CONSUMERS WITH INFORMATION ON ITS
14	POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR:
15	(I) THE SECURITY AND CONFIDENTIALITY OF PROTECTED
16	HEALTH INFORMATION; AND
17	(II) THE USE OF GENETIC TEST DATA IN RESEARCH STUDIES
18	AND
19	(5) THE PERSON OBTAINS THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF A CONSUMER
20	BEFORE USING OR PROVIDING TO ANOTHER PERSON THE CONSUMER'S NAME OF
21	OTHER IDENTIFYING INFORMATION FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN TO
22	COMMUNICATE WITH THE CONSUMER ABOUT THE CONSUMER'S GENETIC TEST.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

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October 1, 2016.
