1 AN ACT concerning

2 Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System – Crisfield Police Department

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring membership in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension 4 System for certain local law enforcement officers of the Crisfield Police Department $\mathbf{5}$ under certain circumstances; providing that a certain individual is entitled to 6 eligibility service and creditable service that was earned before the effective date of 7 the Crisfield Police Department's participation in the Law Enforcement Officers' 8 Pension System; providing that an individual who receives certain service credit is 9 not a member of and has no rights to a benefit in the Employees' Pension System; providing for the transfer of creditable service for a certain individual; providing for 1011 the transfer and crediting of certain assets on the effective date of participation; and 12generally relating to the Crisfield Police Department's participation in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System. 13

20**(B)** NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IF THE CRISFIELD 21POLICE DEPARTMENT BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE 22LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM, MEMBERSHIP IN THE LAW 23**ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM IS MANDATORY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL** 24DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

IF THE CRISFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMENCES PARTICIPATION 25**(C)** IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH 2627SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS ENTITLED TO ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AND CREDITABLE 28SERVICE IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM FOR 2930 EMPLOYMENT WITH THE CRISFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE 31 DATE.

ON JOINING THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM 32**(**D**)** AND RECEIVING SERVICE CREDIT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 33 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 34 35 SHALL:

1 (1) NO LONGER BE A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION 2 SYSTEM; AND

3 (2) HAVE NO FURTHER RIGHTS TO ANY BENEFIT IN THE EMPLOYEES'
 4 PENSION SYSTEM.

5 (E) THE TRANSFER OF CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL 6 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE 7 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM THROUGH THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO 8 TRANSFERS TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM UNDER THIS 9 SECTION, IS NOT GOVERNED BY TITLE 37 OF THIS ARTICLE.

10 (F) IF THE CRISFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT BECOMES A PARTICIPATING 11 GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM, § 12 **31–2A–05(C)** OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL GOVERN THE TRANSFER AND CREDITING OF 13 ASSETS ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2022.
