

- [(d)] (E) Except as provided in regulations adopted by the Board under subsection [(f)] (G) of this section, the license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor during the hours and days as set out for a Class B beer, wine, and liquor (on–sale) license under § 31–2004(c) of this title.
- 5 [(e)] **(F)** (1) The annual license fee is \$1,000.
- 6 (2) The fee for a Sunday permit is \$250.
- 7 **[(f)] (G)** The Board may adopt regulations to carry out this section, including 8 regulations that:
- 9 (1) provide for the manner of dispensing beer, wine, and liquor under the 10 license;
- 11 (2) provide for the hours and days of sale; and
- 12 (3) limit the quantity of alcoholic beverages that may be sold to an 13 individual as a single serving or during a 24-hour period.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
