1 AN ACT concerning

Gas and Electricity – Analog, Digital, and Smart Meters – Meter Exchange and Transmission of Information

FOR the purpose of requiring a utility company to exchange an analog, digital, or smart
meter for another certain meter under certain circumstances; prohibiting a utility
company from charging or penalizing a customer for taking certain actions; requiring
that a certain utility customer have the opportunity to choose the frequency with
which a certain meter transmits certain information; defining certain terms; and
generally relating to utility service and analog, digital, and smart meters.

21 (2) "SMART METER" MEANS A DIGITAL METER THAT ALLOWS 22 TWO–WAY COMMUNICATION BETWEEN A UTILITY CUSTOMER'S PREMISES AND A 23 UTILITY COMPANY THROUGH A WIRELESS NETWORK AS A COMPONENT OF 24 ADVANCED METERING INFRASTRUCTURE.
