1 AN ACT concerning

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State Highways – Electronic Map of Public Trash Receptacles

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Transportation to develop and make available to the public on its website in an accessible and searchable electronic 4 $\mathbf{5}$ format a map of each trash receptacle at a rest area, a welcome center, an exhibit 6 center, a toll facility, or any other public facility operated by the Department or a 7 unit of the Department that is within the right-of-way of an interstate or State 8 highway; requiring the map to include certain information; requiring the map to be 9 updated or audited in a certain manner and according to a certain schedule; and generally relating to an electronic map of trash receptacles at public facilities 1011 operated by the Department of Transportation.
