A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Human Services – Family Navigation Services – Provision and Funding

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor's Office for Children to fund family navigation 4 services to support parents and other caregivers of children or youth with certain $\mathbf{5}$ behavioral health needs or developmental disabilities and to address certain other 6 priorities concerning children and youth; specifying that the family navigation 7 services shall be provided by certain family navigators as determined by local 8 management boards; authorizing local management boards to choose to provide 9 family navigation services based on local needs; requiring a local management board that chooses to provide family navigation services to use funds provided by the Office 10 11 to administer the services; requiring a certain family navigator to support, educate, 12and assist certain parents and caregivers in understanding and addressing certain 13 needs and disabilities, identifying community resources, and obtaining needed services; requiring the Governor to include a certain appropriation for family 14 15navigation services in the annual budget each fiscal year; defining certain terms; and 16generally relating to the provision and funding of family navigation services.

14 A FAMILY NAVIGATOR SHALL SUPPORT, EDUCATE, AND ASSIST A PARENT OR 15 CAREGIVER OF A CHILD OR YOUTH WITH BEHAVIORAL HEALTH NEEDS OR A 16 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY IN:

17 (1) UNDERSTANDING AND ADDRESSING THE CHILD'S OR YOUTH'S 18 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH NEEDS OR DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES;

- 20 (3) OBTAINING NEEDED SERVICES.

FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION OF NOT LESS THAN \$1,665,915 FOR FAMILY NAVIGATION SERVICES.
