## 2 Environment – Wetlands and Waterways – Riparian Rights

- FOR the purpose of specifying that the riparian rights of a community association or other entity may not be terminated or impaired as a result of erosion, sea level rise, or the issuance of certain approvals; requiring the Department of the Environment to establish and maintain a certain repository on the Department's website for certain purposes; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to riparian rights.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 18 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION THAT
- 19 POSSESSES RIPARIAN RIGHTS, INCLUDING THROUGH AN EXPRESS RESERVATION OF
- 20 RIPARIAN RIGHTS TO CONTROL ACCESS TO THE WATER IN A DEED OR OTHER
- 21 RECORDED INSTRUMENT.
- 22 (B) THE RIPARIAN RIGHTS OF A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION OR ENTITY MAY
- 23 NOT BE TERMINATED OR IMPAIRED AS A RESULT OF:



(1) EROSION OR SEA LEVEL RISE; OR

- 2 (2) THE ISSUANCE OF AN APPROVAL BY A COUNTY, THE 3 DEPARTMENT, OR THE BOARD TO A WATERFRONT PROPERTY OWNER, INCLUDING THE ISSUANCE OF A WETLANDS AND WATERWAYS OR A BUILDING PERMIT, LICENSE, OR OTHER APPROVAL.
- 6 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A PUBLICLY 7 ACCESSIBLE REPOSITORY ON THE DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE TO KEEP RECORD OF 8 COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS AND OTHER ENTITIES THAT POSSESS RIPARIAN RIGHTS.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2021.
