- 2. A DEPENDENT OF THE CONTRACT EMPLOYEE WHO IS RESIDING WITH THE CONTRACT EMPLOYEE OUTSIDE THE STATE.
- 21 (2) The license also shall remain in effect, if it would otherwise have 22 expired under this section, for a period of 30 days following the date of the licensee's return 23 to this State, or the member's discharge or separation from active service:
- 24 (i) If the licensee has in the licensee's immediate possession, 25 together with the licensee's driver's license, papers indicating the member's active service 26 outside this State or the member's discharge or separation; and
- 27 (ii) If the license is not otherwise suspended, revoked, or canceled 28 under this title during the 30–day period.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2024.
