## 1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System – Crisfield Police Department

3 FOR the purpose of requiring membership in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension 4 System for certain local law enforcement officers of the Crisfield Police Department  $\mathbf{5}$ under certain circumstances; providing that a certain individual is entitled to 6 eligibility service and creditable service that was earned before the effective date of 7 the Crisfield Police Department's participation in the Law Enforcement Officers' 8 Pension System; providing that an individual who receives certain service credit is 9 not a member of and has no rights to a benefit in the Employees' Pension System; 10 providing for the transfer of creditable service for a certain individual; providing for 11 the transfer and crediting of certain assets on the effective date of participation; and 12generally relating to the Crisfield Police Department's participation in the Law 13Enforcement Officers' Pension System.

3	<b>Article – State Personnel and Pensions</b>

5	(c) (1) On the effective date:
6 7 8	(i) the assets to the credit of the local plan or State system that relate to the law enforcement officers, firefighters, or paramedics who elect to become members shall be transferred to the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System; and
9 10 11	(ii) the trustee or other administrative head of the local plan or State system shall certify the proportion of the funds of the local plan or State system that represents the accumulated contributions of the members as of that date.
12 13 14	(2) The accumulated contributions shall be credited to the respective annuity savings accounts of the members in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System.

27 28 29 30 31	(B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IF THE CRISFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM, MEMBERSHIP IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM IS MANDATORY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

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1 (C) IF THE CRISFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMENCES PARTICIPATION 2 IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH 3 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION 4 (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION IS ENTITLED TO ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AND CREDITABLE 5 SERVICE IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM FOR 6 EMPLOYMENT WITH THE CRISFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE 7 DATE.

8 (D) ON JOINING THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM 9 AND RECEIVING SERVICE CREDIT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 10 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION 11 SHALL:

12 (1) NO LONGER BE A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION 13 SYSTEM; AND

14 (2) HAVE NO FURTHER RIGHTS TO ANY BENEFIT IN THE EMPLOYEES'
15 PENSION SYSTEM.

16 (E) THE TRANSFER OF CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL 17 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE 18 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM THROUGH THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO 19 TRANSFERS TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM UNDER THIS 20 SECTION, IS NOT GOVERNED BY TITLE 37 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(F) IF THE CRISFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT BECOMES A PARTICIPATING
GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM, §
31–2A–05(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL GOVERN THE TRANSFER AND CREDITING OF
ASSETS ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE.
