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## Commercial Solar Facilities - Vicinity Tariff

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring an electric company to make available to certain retail electric 4 customers a certain discount on a certain rate based on the location of a certain meter 5 within a certain distance from a certain solar facility; requiring the discount to be 6 included in a certain tariff; requiring the discount to be offered on an opt-in basis; 7 requiring the electric company to provide certain notice of the discount to certain 8 customers each year in a certain manner; defining a certain term; providing for the 9 application of this Act; and generally relating to electricity rates and commercial solar facilities. 10

  - (E) THE ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL NOTIFY EACH ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER

MADE AVAILABLE TO THE CUSTOMER ON AN OPT-IN BASIS.
