A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Institutions of Higher Education - Pregnant Students - Policy

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an institution of higher education from requiring pregnant 4 students to take a leave of absence, withdraw, or limit studies; requiring an 5 institution of higher education to allow pregnant students, students who have 6 recently given birth, and students who are the nonbirth parents of a recently born 7 child to take a certain leave of absence and return to the institution in good academic 8 standing, subject to a certain condition; requiring an institution of higher education 9 to make reasonable accommodations for pregnant students and designate a certain 10 lactation space at the institution; requiring an institution of higher education to 11 adopt and implement a certain policy, post the policy on the institution's website and 12 in certain locations, and provide a copy of the policy to certain individuals at certain times; and generally relating to pregnant students at institutions of higher 13 education. 14

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT ALL STUDENTS AT AN

- 1 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE, REGARDLESS OF THEIR
- 2 GENDER, SHALL ENJOY FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING
- 3 PREGNANCY DISCRIMINATION AS DESCRIBED IN TITLE IX OF THE EDUCATION
- 4 AMENDMENTS OF 1972.
- 5 (B) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY NOT REQUIRE A STUDENT
- 6 TO TAKE A LEAVE OF ABSENCE, WITHDRAW FROM A PROGRAM, OR LIMIT A
- 7 STUDENT'S STUDIES DUE TO A STUDENT'S PREGNANCY OR FOR OTHER
- 8 PREGNANCY-RELATED REASONS.
- 9 (C) (1) (I) EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ALLOW A
- 10 STUDENT TO TAKE A LEAVE OF ABSENCE BECAUSE THE STUDENT IS PREGNANT OR
- 11 HAS RECENTLY GIVEN BIRTH.
- 12 (II) A LEAVE OF ABSENCE UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL:
- 13 1. BE GRANTED FOR NOT LESS THAN 12 MONTHS,
- 14 UNLESS THE STUDENT REQUESTS A SHORTER LEAVE PERIOD;
- 15 2. INCLUDE TIME TO PREPARE FOR AND TAKE
- 16 PRELIMINARY OR QUALIFYING EXAMINATIONS TO RETURN TO CLASS; AND
- 17 3. ALLOW FOR AN EXTENSION IF MEDICALLY
- 18 NECESSARY.
- 19 (2) (I) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ALLOW A
- 20 STUDENT WHO IS NOT THE BIRTH PARENT TO TAKE A LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR THE
- 21 BIRTH OF THEIR CHILD.
- 22 (II) A LEAVE OF ABSENCE UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL:
- 23 1. BE GRANTED FOR NOT LESS THAN 1 MONTH, UNLESS
- 24 THE STUDENT REQUESTS A SHORTER LEAVE PERIOD;
- 25 2. INCLUDE TIME TO PREPARE FOR AND TAKE
- 26 PRELIMINARY OR QUALIFYING EXAMINATIONS TO RETURN TO CLASS; AND
- 27 3. ALLOW FOR AN EXTENSION IF MEDICALLY
- 28 NECESSARY.
- 29 (3) If A STUDENT IS IN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING AT THE
- 30 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION BEFORE TAKING A LEAVE OF ABSENCE UNDER
- 31 THIS SUBSECTION, THE INSTITUTION SHALL RETURN THE STUDENT TO GOOD

- 1 ACADEMIC STANDING WHEN THE LEAVE OF ABSENCE CONCLUDES.
- 2 (D) (1) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL MAKE
- 3 REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS FOR A PREGNANT STUDENT SO THAT THE
- 4 STUDENT MAY COMPLETE THEIR COURSES OF STUDY AND RESEARCH.
- 5 (2) REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY
- 6 INCLUDE CONSIDERATIONS FOR THE PREGNANT STUDENT'S HEALTH AND SAFETY,
- 7 INCLUDING ALLOWING:
- 8 (I) A STUDENT TO MAINTAIN A SAFE DISTANCE FROM
- 9 HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES OR EQUIPMENT;
- 10 (II) A STUDENT TO MAKE UP TESTS AND ASSIGNMENTS THAT
- 11 WERE MISSED FOR PREGNANCY-RELATED REASONS; AND
- 12 (III) MEDICALLY NECESSARY EXCUSED ABSENCES.
- 13 (E) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL DESIGNATE A PRIVATE
- 14 LACTATION SPACE AT THE INSTITUTION THAT:
- 15 (1) INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE SEATING OPTION WITH A FLAT SURFACE
- 16 AND ELECTRICAL OUTLET NEARBY TO ACCOMMODATE PLACEMENT OF A BREAST
- 17 PUMP DEVICE; AND
- 18 (2) IS NOT A BATHROOM OR CLOSET.
- 19 (F) EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ADOPT AND
- 20 IMPLEMENT A WRITTEN POLICY FOR STUDENTS ON PREGNANCY DISCRIMINATION
- 21 AWARENESS THAT INCLUDES:
- 22 (1) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 23 (2) PROCEDURES FOR ADDRESSING PREGNANCY DISCRIMINATION
- 24 COMPLAINTS UNDER TITLE IX OF THE EDUCATION AMENDMENTS OF 1972 OR THIS
- 25 SECTION.
- 26 (G) EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL:
- 27 (1) POST THE POLICY ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION
- 28 (F) OF THIS SECTION ON THE INSTITUTION'S WEBSITE AND AT APPROPRIATE
- 29 LOCATIONS ON EACH CAMPUS;

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- 1 (2) DISTRIBUTE A COPY OF THE POLICY TO STUDENTS, FACULTY 2 MEMBERS, AND EMPLOYEES AT ALL ORIENTATION SESSIONS; AND
- 3 (3) AT THE REQUEST OF A STUDENT AT A CAMPUS MEDICAL CENTER, 4 PROVIDE A COPY OF THE POLICY TO THE STUDENT.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2022.
