## **HOUSE BILL 179**

- 1 (b) The owner of a vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a lease not intended as security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity that owns the vehicle considered eligible by the Administration may apply to the Administration for the assignment of a commemorative registration plate under this section if the vehicle is included in one of the following classes:
- 6 (1) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;
- 7 (2) A Class E (truck) vehicle [with a manufacturer's rated capacity of one 8 ton or less];
- 9 (3) A Class G (trailer) vehicle; or
- 10 (4) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2016.
