CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of Veterans Affairs – Charlotte Hall Veterans Home Fund –**
3 **Establishment**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home Fund as a special,
5 nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose of the Fund; requiring the Secretary of
6 Veterans Affairs to administer the Fund; prohibiting, except under certain
7 circumstances, any unspent portions of the Fund from being transferred to or
8 reverting to the General Fund of the State; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the
9 Fund and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; specifying the contents of the
10 Fund; specifying the purposes for which the Fund may be used; providing for the
11 investment of money in and expenditures from the Fund; providing that money
12 expended from the Fund for the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home is supplemental to,
13 and is not intended to take the place of, funding that would otherwise be
14 appropriated; requiring the Office of Legislative Audits to audit the accounts and
15 transactions of the Fund as provided in a certain provision of law; defining certain
16 terms; and generally relating to the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home Fund.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

9–912.2.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
INDICATED.

(2) “BED LEASE PAYMENTS” MEANS A DAILY RATE PAID BY THE
CONTRACTOR THAT OPERATES THE CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME TO THE
STATE IN LEASE PAYMENTS BASED ON THE TOTAL NUMBER OF BEDS, REGARDLESS
OF WHETHER ALL OF THE BEDS ARE FILLED.

(3) “FUND” MEANS THE CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME FUND.

(B) THERE IS A CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME FUND.

(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO MAINTAIN THE OPERATION OF THE
CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME.

(D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

(E) (1) (I) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT
SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

(II) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS
PARAGRAPH, ANY UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE FUND MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO
OR REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

(III) IF, AFTER DEDUCTING ALL EXPENSES AUTHORIZED UNDER
SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION, THE REMAINING BALANCE OF THE REVENUE TO
THE DEPARTMENT FROM BED LEASE PAYMENTS AT THE END OF A FISCAL YEAR IS
GREATER THAN 10% OF THE TOTAL BUDGET OF THE CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS
HOME FOR THAT FISCAL YEAR, THE AMOUNT OF THE REMAINING BALANCE THAT IS
IN EXCESS OF 10% OF THE TOTAL BUDGET SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND
OF THE STATE.

(2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY,
AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

1 (F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF BED LEASE PAYMENTS.

2 (G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY FOR:

3 (1) THE SALARIES AND BENEFITS OF THE DEPARTMENTAL STAFF OF
4 THE CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME;

5 (2) IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME;
6 AND

7 (3) ANY OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE CHARLOTTE HALL
8 VETERANS HOME.

9 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND
10 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

11 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO
12 THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

13 (I) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE
14 WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

15 (J) MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE FUND FOR THE CHARLOTTE HALL
16 VETERANS HOME IS SUPPLEMENTAL TO, AND IS NOT INTENDED TO TAKE THE PLACE
17 OF, FUNDING THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE APPROPRIATED FOR THE CHARLOTTE
18 HALL VETERANS HOME.

19 (K) THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS SHALL AUDIT THE ACCOUNTS
20 AND TRANSACTIONS OF THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN § 2-1220 OF THIS ARTICLE.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
22 1, 2016.
