1 AN ACT concerning

Public Schools and County Boards of Education – Publication of School Library Catalogs

- FOR the purpose of requiring each public school to annually provide a copy of the school's library catalog to the county board of education; requiring the county board to compile certain information on the public school's library catalogs and post the information on the county board's website; requiring each public school to annually send the parents or guardians of students who attend the school a link to where certain information on the school's library catalog can be found; and generally relating to the publication of public school library catalogs.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Education
- 19 **7–106.1.**
- 20 (A) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1 EACH YEAR, EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL 21 PROVIDE A COPY OF THE SCHOOL'S LIBRARY CATALOG TO THE COUNTY BOARD.
- 22 (B) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL:

- 1 (1) COMPILE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) 2 OF THIS SECTION; AND
- 3 (2) POST THE INFORMATION ON THE COUNTY BOARD'S WEBSITE.
- 4 (C) (1) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 15 EACH YEAR, EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL SEND THE PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF STUDENTS WHO ATTEND THE SCHOOL A LINK TO THE LOCATION ON THE COUNTY BOARD'S WEBSITE WHERE THE INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION CAN BE FOUND.
- 9 (2) THE LINK TO THE WEBSITE MAY BE SENT ELECTRONICALLY, SENT 10 HOME WITH STUDENTS, OR MAILED TO PARENTS OR GUARDIANS.
- 11 (D) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 12 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
