$\begin{array}{c} 15\\ 16 \end{array}$	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
17 18 19	(2) "CHRONICALLY ABSENT STUDENT" MEANS A STUDENT WHO IS UNLAWFULLY ABSENT FROM SCHOOL FOR MORE THAN 10% OF THE SCHOOL DAYS IN ANY GIVEN QUARTER, SEMESTER, OR ACADEMIC YEAR.
$20 \\ 21$	(3) "UNLAWFUL ABSENCE" HAS THE MEANING SET FORTH IN COMAR 13A.08.01.03 AND 13A.08.01.04.

(B) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP A SYSTEM OF ACTIVE INTERVENTION FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE CHRONICALLY ABSENT FROM SCHOOL.
(C) EACH COUNTY BOARD'S SYSTEM OF INTERVENTION FOR CHRONICALLY ABSENT STUDENTS SHALL INCLUDE:
(1) A ROOT CAUSE ANALYSIS BY QUALIFIED SCHOOL SYSTEM PERSONNEL TO IDENTIFY WHAT FACTORS ARE LEADING TO A STUDENT'S ABSENCES AND TO DEVELOP A PLAN TO ADDRESS THOSE FACTORS; AND

8 (2) IF DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY SCHOOL SYSTEM PERSONNEL, 9 REFERRALS TO SOCIAL SERVICE OR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS WHO MIGHT BE 10 ABLE TO ADDRESS THE ROOT CAUSES OF A STUDENT'S ABSENCES.

11 (D) (1) EACH COUNTY BOARD'S SYSTEM OF INTERVENTION FOR 12 CHRONICALLY ABSENT STUDENTS SHALL REQUIRE INTERACTION BETWEEN 13 SCHOOL SYSTEM PERSONNEL, THE STUDENT, AND THE STUDENT'S PARENTS OR 14 GUARDIAN TO EMPHASIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF REGULAR ATTENDANCE AND 15 STRATEGIES FOR ENSURING REGULAR ATTENDANCE.

16 (2) THIS INTERACTION MAY INCLUDE COUNSELING OR PARENT 17 EDUCATION CLASSES.

18 (E) (1) ANY STUDENT ATTENDING KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 12TH 19 GRADE WHO IS UNLAWFULLY ABSENT MORE THAN 10% OF THE SCHOOL DAYS IN 20 ANY GIVEN QUARTER, SEMESTER, OR ACADEMIC YEAR SHALL IMMEDIATELY BE 21 REFERRED TO THE COUNTY BOARD'S SYSTEM OF ACTIVE INTERVENTION FOR 22 STUDENTS WHO ARE CHRONICALLY ABSENT FROM SCHOOL.

23(2)THE COUNTY BOARD MAY INTERVENE AT A LOWER LEVEL OF24ABSENCES.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 2013.

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
