- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Board of License Commissioners for 4 Anne Arundel County; requiring that each member of the Board represent a different $\mathbf{5}$ legislative district in the county; requiring that the Governor appoint members who 6 have lived in their district for a certain time period; specifying that a member's seat 7 be declared vacant under certain circumstances; requiring that no more than a 8 certain number of members may belong to the same political party; providing that 9 the term of a member continues for a certain number of years and ends on a certain date; providing for the termination of the terms of members of the Board serving on 1011 a certain date; and generally relating to the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County. 12

$4 \\ 5 \\ 6$	(II) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT FROM EACH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY ONE MEMBER WHO HAS LIVED IN THE DISTRICT FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS IMMEDIATELY BEFORE APPOINTMENT.

8 9	(i) if the Senate is in session, with the advice and consent of the Senate; or
10	(ii) if the Senate is not in session, by the Governor alone.

HOUSE BILL 210

1 (2) The Governor shall give a member who is charged a copy of the charges 2 against the member and, with at least 10 days' notice, an opportunity to be heard publicly 3 in person or by counsel.

4 (3) If a member is removed, the Governor shall file with the Office of the 5 Secretary of State a statement of charges against the member and the Governor's findings 6 on the charges.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the members
serving on the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County on the effective
date of this Act shall expire at the end of June 30, 2017.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 11 1, 2017.
