FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from manufacturing for sale or accepting for sale a personal care product or an over—the—counter drug that contains synthetic plastic microbeads on or after certain dates; defining certain terms; and generally relating to synthetic plastic microbeads.

14 Preamble

WHEREAS, Synthetic plastic microbeads, a synthetic alternative ingredient to such natural materials as ground almonds, oatmeal, and pumice, found in over 100 personal care products including facial cleansers, shampoos, and toothpastes, pose a serious threat to the State's environment; and

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WHEREAS, Although synthetic plastic microbeads are a safe and effective mild abrasive ingredient used for gently removing dead skin, there are concerns about the potential environmental impact of these materials; and

WHEREAS, Synthetic plastic microbeads have been documented to collect harmful pollutants already present in the environment and harm fish and other aquatic organisms that form the base of the aquatic food chain; and

WHEREAS, While more research is needed on the potential adverse consequences synthetic plastic microbeads may have on the environment, many cosmetic manufacturers have already begun a voluntary process for identifying alternatives to synthetic plastic microbeads; and

- WHEREAS, Without significant and costly improvements to the majority of the State's sewage treatment facilities, synthetic plastic microbeads will continue to pollute Maryland's waters; now, therefore,
