A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Motor Vehicle Registration – Exception – City of Havre de Grace

3 FOR the purpose of creating an exception to motor vehicle registration requirements under 4 certain circumstances for low speed electric vehicles in the City of Havre de Grace $\mathbf{5}$ that are owned and operated by the City of Havre de Grace; providing that a person 6 who operates a low speed electric vehicle on a roadway in the City of Havre de Grace 7 may operate the low speed electric vehicle only on certain roadways and, at certain 8 times, only if the low speed electric vehicle is equipped with certain lighting devices; 9 requiring a person who operates a low speed electric vehicle on a roadway in the City of Havre de Grace to keep as far to the right of the roadway as feasible and possess 1011 a valid driver's license; authorizing the State Highway Administration, in 12consultation with the City of Havre de Grace, to develop a location in the City of 13 Havre de Grace where a person operating a low speed electric vehicle may cross over 14 a certain roadway; defining a certain term; and generally relating to an exception to 15motor vehicle registration requirements for low speed electric vehicles in the City of 16Havre de Grace.
