1 (g) On or before December 31, [2018] **2019**, the Task Force shall report its 2 findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the 3 State Government Article, the members of the Prince George's County Delegation to the 4 General Assembly.

5 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 6 2018. Section 2 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of [13 months] **2 YEARS AND 1** 7 **MONTH** and, at the end of June 30, [2019] **2020**, Section 2 of this Act, with no further action 8 required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 10 1, 2019.
