Article - Public Utilities 1 2 4-204.3 The Commission may suspend, effective immediately and without (a) (1) formal proceedings, any new rate or change in rate proposed by a public service company. 4 5 (2)Unless suspended by the Commission, and subject to § 4–203 of this 6 subtitle, a new rate or change in rate proposed by a public service company takes effect on the date specified in the rate application. 7 8 The Commission shall furnish to the public service company proposing (3)9 a rate a written statement of the reasons for the suspension. The Commission promptly shall institute proceedings to consider 10 11 whether the suspended rate is a just and reasonable rate. 12 (2) The Commission may: 13 (i) suspend the rate initially for not more than 150 180 days after 14 the proposed effective date; and 15 (ii) 1. extend the suspension for an additional 30 days if the 16 Commission finds that the proceedings cannot be completed within the initial suspension 17 period; OR <u>2.</u> 18 EXTEND THE PROCEEDINGS SUSPENSION FOR UP TO AN ADDITIONAL 120 90 DAYS IF THE FILING IS FOR AN ALTERNATIVE FORM OF 19 20 RATEMAKING FOR AN ELECTRIC COMPANY, A GAS COMPANY, AN ELECTRIC AND GAS 21COMPANY, OR A TELEPHONE COMPANY A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
