16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (a) In this Code and any regulation or directive adopted under it, “legal holiday”
21 means:

22 (16) each statewide **PRIMARY AND** general election day in the State; and
