## 2 Law Enforcement – Federal Surplus Program – Equipment Acquisition

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain law enforcement agencies from receiving certain
  equipment from a federal military surplus program; requiring certain law
  enforcement agencies to post notice of a request for certain equipment from a federal
  military surplus program within a certain period of time; and generally relating to
  local law enforcement agencies and the acquisition of equipment from a federal
  military surplus program.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Public Safety
  - 17 **3–520.**
  - 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 19 INDICATED.
  - 20 (2) "DESTRUCTIVE DEVICE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 4–501 OF 21 THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.

22 (3) "FIREARM SILENCER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 5–621 OF 23 THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.

"LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § (4) 1  $\mathbf{2}$ 3–201 OF THIS TITLE.

"SURPLUS PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM OPERATED BY THE 3 (5) FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS MILITARY EQUIPMENT TO 4  $\mathbf{5}$ A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

6 **(B)** A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY NOT RECEIVE THE FOLLOWING 7 **EQUIPMENT FROM A SURPLUS PROGRAM:** 

- 8 (1) AN ARMORED OR WEAPONIZED:
- 9 **(I)** AIRCRAFT;
- 10 **(II)** DRONE; OR
- 11 (III) VEHICLE;
- 12(2) A DESTRUCTIVE DEVICE;
- 13(3) A FIREARM SILENCER; OR
- (4) 14 A GRENADE LAUNCHER.

WITHIN 14 DAYS AFTER A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY REQUESTS 15**(C)** 16 EQUIPMENT FROM A SURPLUS PROGRAM, THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL POST NOTICE OF THE REQUEST ON A PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE WEBSITE. 17

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 October 1, 2018.
