## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government – Commemorative Days – Maryland Centenarians Day**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor annually to proclaim a certain day as  
4 Maryland Centenarians Day; and generally relating to commemorative days.

5 BY adding to

6 Article – State Government

7 Section 13–410

8 Annotated Code of Maryland

9 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – State Government**

13 **13–410.**

14 **IN RECOGNITION OF THE LIVES OF THE STATE’S CITIZENS WHO HAVE**  
15 **REACHED THE LANDMARK AGE OF 100 YEARS, THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY**  
16 **SHALL PROCLAIM THE SECOND THURSDAY IN MAY AS MARYLAND**  
17 **CENTENARIANS DAY.**

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
19 October 1, 2012.
