- 3 (3) FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR 4 THE APPROPRIATE AGENCY, INSTITUTION, OR LICENSED FACILITY AT WHICH THE 5 PERSON IS EMPLOYED IF THE PERSON IS AN EDUCATOR OR A HUMAN SERVICE 6 WORKER.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2016.
