1 the Secretary of the Environment, or the Secretary's designee; and (7)2 the following representatives: (8)3 (i) one representative from the Dorchester County Emergency Management Division, appointed by the Director of the Dorchester County Department of 4 Emergency Services; 5 6 one representative from the Anne Arundel County Office of 7 Emergency Management, appointed by the Director of the Anne Arundel County Office of Emergency Management; and 8 9 one representative from the St. Mary's County Emergency (iii) Management Division, appointed by the Director of the St. Mary's County Department of 10 Emergency Services. 11 12 The Secretary of Emergency Management, or the Secretary's designee, may appoint additional members to the Workgroup. 13 14 The Secretary of Emergency Management, or the Secretary's designee, shall 15 designate the chair of the Workgroup. 16 The Maryland Department of Emergency Management shall provide staff for (e) 17 the Workgroup. A member of the Workgroup: 18 (f) 19 (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Workgroup; but 20 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State 21Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget. 22 The Workgroup shall study and make recommendations regarding: (g) 23the feasibility of establishing a Waterway Incident Notification System 24to notify members of the public, including recreational boaters and commercial watermen, of active waterway emergencies involving a person at risk of death or serious bodily harm, 2526 emergency marine events, or marine hazards; and 27 potential partnerships among the State, the U.S. Coast Guard, the U.S. (2)28Navy, and nearby states to improve notifications to members of the public, including recreational boaters and commercial watermen, of waterway emergencies involving a 2930 person at risk of death or serious bodily harm, emergency marine events, or marine 31 hazards.

On or before December 31, 2024, the Workgroup shall submit an

interim report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with

1 § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

- 2 (2) On or before September 30, 2025, the Workgroup shall submit a final report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2024. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, 2026, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
