1 (ii) the public body votes on legislation and [the individual votes 2 taken by each member of the public body who participates in the voting are posted] **POSTS** 3 promptly on the Internet:

4 **1.** THE INDIVIDUAL VOTES TAKEN BY EACH MEMBER OF 5 THE PUBLIC BODY WHO PARTICIPATES IN THE VOTING;

6 2. IF APPLICABLE, THE AMENDMENTS PASSED BY THE 7 PUBLIC BODY; AND

8 **3.** IF APPLICABLE, A REPRINT OF THE LEGISLATION 9 THAT INCLUDES THE TEXT OF THE LEGISLATION AS INTRODUCED, INTERLINEATED 10 WITH THE TEXT OF THE AMENDMENTS PASSED BY THE PUBLIC BODY.

11 (3) The information specified under paragraph (2) of this subsection shall 12 be deemed the minutes of the open session.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2017.
