- (B) AS SOON AS POSSIBLE BUT NOT LATER THAN 10 WORKING DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF A REGISTRATION STATEMENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE OR AFTER RECEIPT OF NOTICE OF A REGISTRANT'S CHANGE OF ADDRESS, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SEND NOTICE OF THE REGISTRATION STATEMENT OR CHANGE OF ADDRESS TO EACH RESIDENCE LOCATED WITHIN 1 MILE OF THE RESIDENCE OF THE REGISTRANT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any registration statement or notice of a change of address received by the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services in accordance with Title 11, Subtitle 7 of the Criminal Procedure Article before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
