CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Regulation of Parking – Jurisdiction**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying that certain State and local entities may regulate the parking
4 of vehicles on highways over which the entity has jurisdiction; and generally relating
5 to State and local jurisdiction over the regulation of parking.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Transportation**

1 (a) On every highway under its jurisdiction, the State Highway Administration
2 shall place and maintain those traffic control devices that it considers necessary to carry
3 out the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law or to regulate, warn, or guide traffic. Each
4 of these traffic control devices shall conform to the manual and specifications of the State
5 Highway Administration.

6 (b) A local authority may place or maintain a traffic control device on a highway
7 under the jurisdiction of the State Highway Administration only with the permission and
8 under the direction of the State Highway Administration.

9 26–301.

10 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, any State agency authorized by law
11 and any political subdivision of this State may adopt ordinances or regulations that:

12 (1) Regulate the parking of vehicles **ON HIGHWAYS OVER WHICH THE**
13 **STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION HAS JURISDICTION;**

14 (2) Provide for the impounding of vehicles parked in violation of the
15 ordinances or regulations;

16 (3) Regulate the towing of vehicles from publicly owned and privately
17 owned parking lots; and

18 (4) Provide for the issuance of a citation by an officer for a violation of an
19 ordinance or regulation that is adopted under this section.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2015.
