AN ACT concerning
Natural Resources - Organized Killing Contests - Restriction
FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from sponsoring, conducting, or participating in certain organized contests that have the objective of killing certain wildlife for prizes or monetary awards; providing for the construction of this Act; establishing a certain penalty for a violation of this Act; and generally relating to restrictions on organized killing contests.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

> Article - Natural Resources

(A) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON MAY NOT SPONSOR, CONDUCT, OR PARTICIPATE IN A CONTEST ORGANIZED IN THE STATE THAT HAS THE OBJECTIVE OF KILLING A COYOTE, FOX, OR RACCOON FOR PRIZES OR MONETARY REWARDS.
(B) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT:
(1) A LANDOWNER OR THE LANDOWNER'S AGENT OR LESSEE FROM

1 KILLING COYOTES, FOXES, OR RACCOONS ON PROPERTY OF THE LANDOWNER, 2 PROVIDED THAT THE KILLING IS NOT PART OF AN ORGANIZED CONTEST; OR
