- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Montgomery 5 County to issue a catering extension to a holder of a Class D beer, wine, and liquor 6 license; providing that a catering extension authorizes a holder of a Class D beer, 7 wine, and liquor license to provide alcoholic beverages at an event that is held off the 8 premises under certain circumstances and only during certain times and days; 9 providing that the holder of a Class D beer, wine, and liquor license is not required 10 to obtain a catering extension under certain circumstances; and generally relating to 11 the sale of alcoholic beverages in Montgomery County.
