- 20 (2) On or before December 1, [2021] **2022**, the Commission shall submit a final report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with 22 [§ 2–1246] § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

- 1 1, 2019. It shall remain effective for a period of [3] 4 years and 1 month and, at the end of
- 2 June 30, [2022] 2023, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
