A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Insurance – Licensed Clinical Professional Art Therapists –**
3 **Reimbursement**

4 FOR the purpose of adding a licensed clinical professional art therapist to the types of
5 licensed clinical counselors and therapists whose services entitle an insured or
6 certain other persons to reimbursement, under certain circumstances, under certain
7 health insurance policies, contracts, or certificates; and generally relating to health
8 insurance reimbursement for the services of licensed clinical professional art
9 therapists.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Insurance**

18 15–704.

19 (a) This section applies to each individual, group, or blanket health insurance
20 policy, contract, or certificate of an insurer or nonprofit health service plan that:

21 (1) (i) is delivered or issued for delivery in the State;

22 (ii) is issued to a group that is incorporated or has a main office in
23 the State; or

1 (iii) covers individuals who reside or work in the State; and

2 (2) is issued, renewed, amended, or reissued on or after October 1, 2003.

3 (b) If a policy, contract, or certificate subject to this section provides for
4 reimbursement for a service that is within the lawful scope of practice of a licensed clinical
5 professional counselor, a licensed clinical marriage and family therapist, [or] a licensed
6 clinical alcohol and drug counselor, **OR A LICENSED CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL ART**
7 **THERAPIST**, the insured or any other person covered by the policy or certificate is entitled
8 to reimbursement for the service.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2017.
