paragraph (2) of this subsection], the Board may DENY A LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT
FOR A FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE, reprimand[,] THE HOLDER OF A
FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE, place THE HOLDER OF A FUNERAL
ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE on probation, [deny,] OR suspend[,] or revoke a funeral
establishment license [for]:
(1) FOR any of the grounds listed in subsection (a) of this section; OR
[(2) The Board may not reprimand, place on probation, deny, suspends or revoke a funeral establishment license because of a violation of a provision of this title by an employee of the establishment, unless the employee has a proprietary interest in the business that is conducted from the establishment.]
(2) BECAUSE OF A VIOLATION OF A PROVISION OF THIS TITLE BY AN EMPLOYEE OF THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
