FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Education to post a training video on 4 5 hands-only cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated 6 defibrillators on its Web site; requiring the training video to be obtained by the 7 State Board at no charge, if possible, and to be no more than a certain number 8 of minutes in duration; requiring each county board of education to publicize the 9 training video in a certain manner and encourage certain individuals to view the training video; and generally relating to the posting of a training video on 10 hands-only cardiopulmonary resuscitation and automated external 11

- 5 (2) BE NO MORE THAN 15 MINUTES IN DURATION.
- 6 (C) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL:
- 7 (1) PUBLICIZE THE TRAINING VIDEO REQUIRED UNDER 8 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION ON SCHOOL SYSTEM WEB SITES AND IN 9 NEWSLETTERS, BULLETINS, CALENDARS, AND OTHER CORRESPONDENCE 10 CURRENTLY PUBLISHED BY EACH COUNTY BOARD; AND
- 11 (2) ENCOURAGE SCHOOL PERSONNEL AND PARENTS AND 12 GUARDIANS OF STUDENTS TO VIEW THE TRAINING VIDEO.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
