## 2 Somerset County - Community College - Eligibility of Students to Pay No 3 Tuition or Fees

FOR the purpose of providing that certain students residing in Somerset County may enroll 4 5 full time in certain community colleges and pay no tuition or fees for a certain time 6 if certain conditions are met; requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission 7 to pay 100% of in-county tuition and fees for certain eligible students from certain 8 funds and subject to certain conditions; requiring that certain student financial aid 9 be applied to pay an eligible student's tuition and fees before determining the amount required to be paid by the Commission; requiring a student to repay funds spent on 10 11 the student's behalf to the Commission and county if the student is guilty of a felony; 12 prohibiting a student from being eligible to pay no tuition or fees under this Act if the student is convicted of a felony; and generally relating to the eligibility of 13 students residing in Somerset County to attend community college and pay no 14 tuition or fees. 15

- (b) (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2), (3), and (4) of this subsection and subsection (g) of this section, any student who attends a community college not supported by the county in which the student resides shall pay, in addition to the student tuition and fees payable by a resident of a county that supports the community college, an out—of—county or out—of—region fee at least equal to 60% of the county share per full—time equivalent student as determined under § 16–305 of this subtitle.
- 9 (e) (1) Notwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, if any student resides in a county where the per capita wealth is below the State average and the county does not 10 support a community college or a branch campus of a community college, except for 11 12 Baltimore City, the student may enroll at a community college or a branch campus in the State, either of which is located in a county adjacent to the one in which the student resides, 13 14 and pay only the tuition and fees applicable to a county resident that supports the 15 community college.
- 16 (2) For any student determined to be eligible under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the Commission shall pay:
- 18 (i) In fiscal year 1992, 75% of any applicable out—of—county fee 19 provided that the county in which the student resides pays 25 percent of that fee; and
- 20 (ii) In fiscal year 1993, and each fiscal year thereafter, 50% of any 21 applicable out–of–county fee provided that the county in which the student resides pays 50 22 percent of that fee.
- 23 (3) The Commission may make payments to effectuate the provisions of 24 [this section] PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION from funds specifically appropriated 25 for this purpose in the State budget or any supplemental budget request.
- 26 **(4) (I)** ANY STUDENT WHO IS DETERMINED TO BE ELIGIBLE UNDER 27PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND WHO RESIDES IN SOMERSET COUNTY 28 MAY ENROLL FULL TIME AT AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF 29 THIS SUBSECTION IN THE FALL SEMESTER IMMEDIATELY AFTER GRADUATING FROM 30 HIGH SCHOOL AND PAY NO TUITION OR FEES FOR UP TO 3 YEARS OR UNTIL 31 COMPLETION OF AN ASSOCIATE'S DEGREE, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST, IF THE 32 STUDENT:
- 1. ANNUALLY SUBMITS, IN A TIMELY MANNER, THE FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID AND AN APPLICATION FOR STATE FINANCIAL AID;

- 23. MAINTAINS AT LEAST A 2.00 GPA;
