1 AN ACT concerning

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Education – Coaches – Mental Health First Aid Training

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, in collaboration with the 4 Maryland Department of Health, each county board of education, and the Maryland $\mathbf{5}$ Public Secondary Schools Athletic Association, to develop guidelines for public 6 schools to train coaches in providing mental health first aid to recognize indicators 7 of mental illness and behavioral distress in students; requiring each public school in the State that offers a mainstream athletic program to provide <u>a certain</u> mental 8 9 health first aid training to coaches; requiring the Maryland Higher Education 10 Commission, in collaboration with the Maryland Department of Health, to develop 11 guidelines for public institutions of higher education to train coaches in providing 12 mental health first aid to recognize indicators of mental illness and behavioral 13distress in students; requiring a public institution of higher education that offers an 14 athletic program to provide a certain mental health first aid training to coaches; and 15generally relating to coaches and mental health first aid training.
