# State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing Aid Dispensers, and Speech–Language Pathologists – Cease and Desist Orders and Injunctive Relief

 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, 6 Hearing Aid Dispensers, and Speech-Language Pathologists to issue cease and 7 desist orders or obtain injunctive relief for violations of certain provisions of 8 law; authorizing an action to be maintained in the name of the State or the Board to enjoin certain unauthorized practice or conduct that is a ground for 9 certain disciplinary action; authorizing a certain action to be brought by certain 10 persons and in certain locations; providing that proof of certain damages is not 11 12required for a certain action; providing that a certain action is in addition to and 13 not instead of certain criminal prosecution or disciplinary action; repealing 14authorization for the Board to sue to enforce certain provisions of law; and generally relating to the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing 1516 Aid Dispensers, and Speech–Language Pathologists and cease and desist orders 17and injunctive relief.
