Washington County - Alcoholic Beverages - Wine Festival License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a special wine festival (WF) license in Washington 4 County; requiring that an applicant for a special WF license must be a holder of 5 a certain other license; specifying that a holder of a special WF license may 6 display and sell wine in a certain manner; requiring the Washington County 7 Board of License Commissioners to assure that the primary focus of the Festival 8 is the promotion of Maryland wine; requiring a holder of a special WF license to 9 display and sell certain wine; providing for a license fee; providing that this Act 10 does not prohibit the holder of a special WF license from holding another 11 alcoholic beverages license; authorizing the Board to choose certain weekends for festivals; requiring the Board to choose certain locations for the festivals; 12 requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and 13 generally relating to wine in Washington County. 14
